Monday, June 4, 2012 @ 6 PM

WELCOME: Mayor Interim Daniel Braswell opened the meeting at 6:23 PM.

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

- City Clerk Sanders announced that Fire Chief Mike Kellems called and said he would be a little late.
- The budget for the Sewer budget was the first item discussed.
- Councilwoman Rogers commended the fire department for its quick response to a fire call
- The budget for the Fire department was the second item discussed, with Chief Kellems providing the Council and audience with a copy of his proposed budget. Highlights of that discussion were:
 - ✓ The capital outlay line item was increased to accommodate bringing the fire station on Highway 278 up to code as per the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
 - ✓ Councilwoman Rogers questioned why there were no funds budgeted for the Atomic City Festival.
 - ✓ Chief Kellems introduced the concept of having eight (8) hours of pay daily for volunteers in order to continue meeting one of the requirements for ISO inspection, which he intends to request in the near future.
- The budget for Streets and Roads department was the third item discussed
- The budget for Victim's Assistance was discussed
- Council decided they would have to agree on a direction for the Civic Center before they could realistically discuss the budget for that facility. It was further agreed that the revenues would be discussed at the next meeting, which will be held on June 11, 2012.

ADJOURNMENT:

Mayor Pro Tem Terence Williams called for a motion to adjourn the meeting, announcing that no actions had been taken on any items discussed.
