COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:

***Frank Artusa-Artusa Construction**-Not present when called to speak

***Anna Hilpert**-resident that does not want construction of homes in golf course area; "people don't trust what is going on"; infrastructure needs of existing home should be addressed before adding additional homes

***Joseph Bradrick**-started petition to not have zoning change from R-15 to R-7; 172 signatures of residents that don't want the subdivision. *Petition referenced will be available at www.newellentonsc.com with minutes*

***Glenn Griffin**-Not opposed to growth-would like a smaller number than 204 homes; maybe 102 homes

*Councilman Culpepper response to Griffin-not financially feasible for investor in that area to decrease number of homes.

***Ashley Foreman, III**- Rain & storm water run-off issue currently and would like it addressed before building which would increase the problem; would like to have sufficient collection and release so backyard isn't consistently flooding.

***Lavon Griffin**-Not present when called to speak

***Nathan Pruet**- current issues should be addressed now before adding that many homes.

***Greg MacDonald**-major issue with development is the traffic; asked that there will be speed bumps to deter speeding.

*Mayor Kim Williams & Councilman Morgan-have been working with SCDOT to address the concerns for speed bump installation

***Lynne Taylor**-Trash hasn't been collected in weeks on Bent Tree Rd; called numerous times concerning issue

*City Clerk-Administration has reached out to Waste Management and because of road being a hazard for their trucks to collect on Bent Tree, Waste Management is looking into service being cancelled through them allowing residents to take their trash to county dump site or acquire another company's service (city ordinance requires city residents to pay for collection service offered through the city; Waste Management determining that Bent Tree residents will not be able to be serviced will allow waiver of requirement).

***Carter Ryan**-resident on Key Ave. where storm drains are an issue

***Autumn Stevens**-Asked council, "Please, don't take my house from me." Feels infrastructure can't handle the new development.

***Chief Shawn Middleton(police)**-One officer started the academy today; wants the right people in positions of officer; wants officers that are straight, firm and know the law; if there are speeding concerns throughout the city let him know and he will address the concerns; available almost every day.

Council discussion before vote

Carl Culpepper, III-looking at growth for the city and know that businesses won't come without seeing that council is committed to growth; have to keep citizens buying within the city; a lot of variables may potentially stop build; voted in approval of motion.

Ricky Foster asked for change from R-15 to R-10 because there are too many houses proposed in that area-that request was denied; voted in opposition of motion

Faye Durham-expressed that she would like to see growth and during campaign there many people desiring growth; catch 22-growth requires business and business requires people; voted in favor of motion; SRP bank bought old Popeye's with plans to open here and that plan was based on building of the new homes; listened to residents that want to see more in the city and with Atomic City Festival and those things require money.

Elvira Johnson-Holley-echoed previous council; desires growth in the city and doesn't want tax dollars being used outside the city; would like to see the tax dollars used to beautify this area; it's going to take everyone being involved; not voted on council to sit back; working with and for you all and for ourselves because we want growth here; doesn't like conversation that the city has died out.

Petition Against Rezoning New Ellenton Golf Course Area

We, the undersigned, concerned citizens of New Ellenton, petition City Council to deny Great Southern Homes' unnecessary request to rezone the New Ellenton Golf Course area from R15 (single-family homes with a minimum ~1/3 acre lot size) to R7 (single- and/or two-family homes with a minimum ~1/6 acre lot size).

The current zoning is sufficient as is and will be more effective at maintaining the relatively quiet, peaceful character of the area whereas R7 rezoning will permanently and negatively impact our community and quality of life while creating unnecessary strain on our unreliable and inadequate infrastructure.

This rezoning request has only one purpose - to cram as many people into as small a space as possible. Such crowded, vehicle-packed, and almost yardless neighborhoods are eyesores that would violently clash with the surrounding area. They foster both undesirable and potentially dangerous issues, such as increased traffic, concentrated noise, and safety hazards related to street parking, all inevitable by-products that plague these types of neighborhoods.. and all issues which are directly affected by lot size.

Furthermore, the area already suffers from frequent water main breaks, a lack of city-provided household sewage service, unreliable trash service, a [city-wide] complete lack of local nighttime law enforcement, and a largely unavoidable, dangerous intersection that worsens with increased traffic. Although any residential development will strain our infrastructure, an R7 development will exacerbate issues more severely than an R15 development would.
